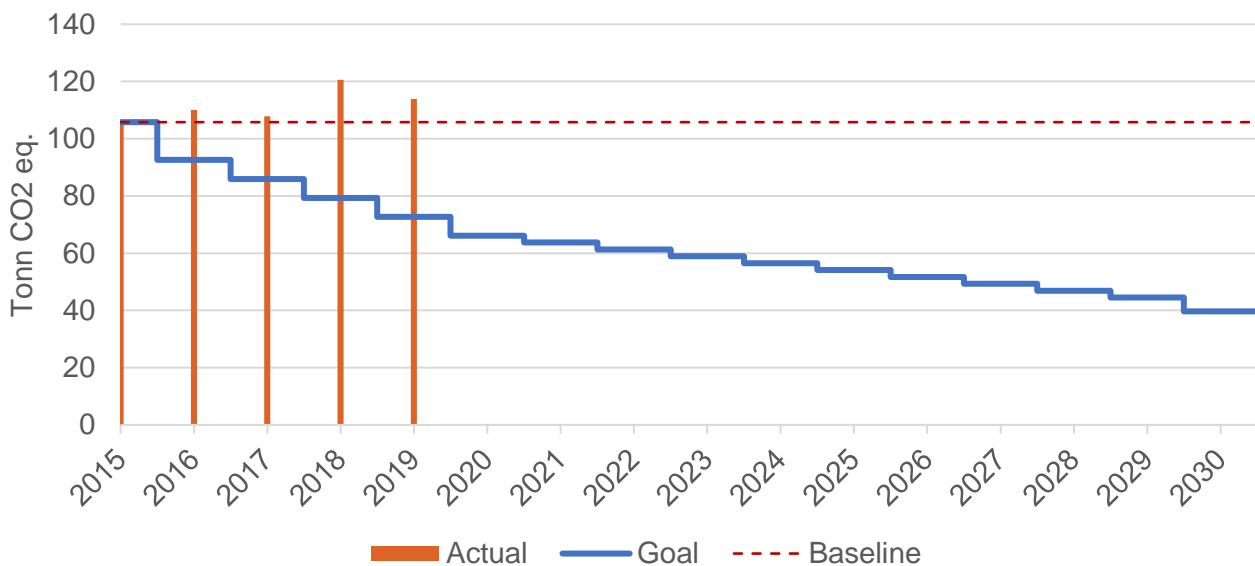


Emissions from Employee Commuting

The following graphs display the emissions and goals of the Reykjavik Energy group from commuting to and from work from 2015 – 2030 and the group’s achievement towards these goals. In 2019, emissions surpassed the 2015 baseline for commuting, but on a per-employee-basis Reykjavik Energy did go below the 2015 baseline per employee. Staff must and will be continued to be encouraged to use environmentally friendly modes of transport. Reykjavik Energy, along with several companies in the Hálsas area, initiated an encouragement towards the local bus transport company Straeto bs. to improve bus transport in the area, in which about 1% of the population works. In order to assess the emissions coming from commuting, the residence of employees were estimated according to zip code, in accordance with the GHG Protocol.
